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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SOUL SURVIVOR OUTDOOR

1. The name of this corporation is Soul Survivor Outdoor.
2. This corporation is a Religious Corporation and is not organized for private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Religious Corporation Law exclusively for religious purposes.
3. The specific purpose of this corporation is to evangelize, support, train, educate and disciple into Christian faith members of the military community through activities including, but not limited to, Bible studies, leadership training, mentoring, outdoor recreational events, coaching, special events and international travel. The corporation shall further promote the Christian lifestyle in the community by encouraging a closer personal relationship with Jesus Christ among its members.
4. The name and address in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is Richard Wolf, 3437 Ravine Drive, Carlsbad, CA 92010.
5. The street and mailing address of this corporation is 3437 Ravine Drive, Carlsbad, CA 92010.
6. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.
7. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for political office.
8. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.
9. Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational an/or religious purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.
