ORIENTATION: Joshua Tree National Park, CA – Thursday 29 January 2026

SITUATION: (40) Active duty military personnel of any rank **who have not previously attended an SSO event** are invited to participate in a rock-climbing event. Event will focus on strengthening spiritual fitness and resiliency. Military service members will have an opportunity to participate in a meal, listen to a guest speaker, and engage in individual and group discussion in a wilderness setting. Additionally, the event is intended to give service members a chance to relax and let their guard down, unpack the stress of daily life, refresh their spirit, clear their minds, and restore the soul.

MISSION: Thursday 29 January 2026. Service members will participate in a wilderness event at Joshua Tree, CA in order to focus on resiliency and spiritual fitness. The event will also promote stress reduction and restoration of the soul.

EXECUTION:

1) Commanders Intent –

- a. **Purpose.** Strengthen spiritual fitness and resiliency.
- b. **Method.** Via rock climbing, meal and discussion at Joshua Tree National Park, CA. Ensure senior service member is identified and all participation forms turned in.
- c. **Endstate.** Foster increased spiritual fitness and individual resiliency.

2) Concept of Operations –

- a. **Phase I.** Shaping (19 December 2025 through 20 January 2026): Gather interest and screen potential participants.
- b. **Phase II.** Execution (Thursday 29 January 2026): Service members will depart command location as required for Indian Cove - Joshua Tree National Park, (see map) followed by accountability. Mission is complete when all Service members have returned to point of origin and are accounted for Thursday 29 January 2026. Once accountability is complete, personnel will return to their respective areas.
- c. **Phase III.** Sustainment – Completion of Event - Participants Complete Google Review.

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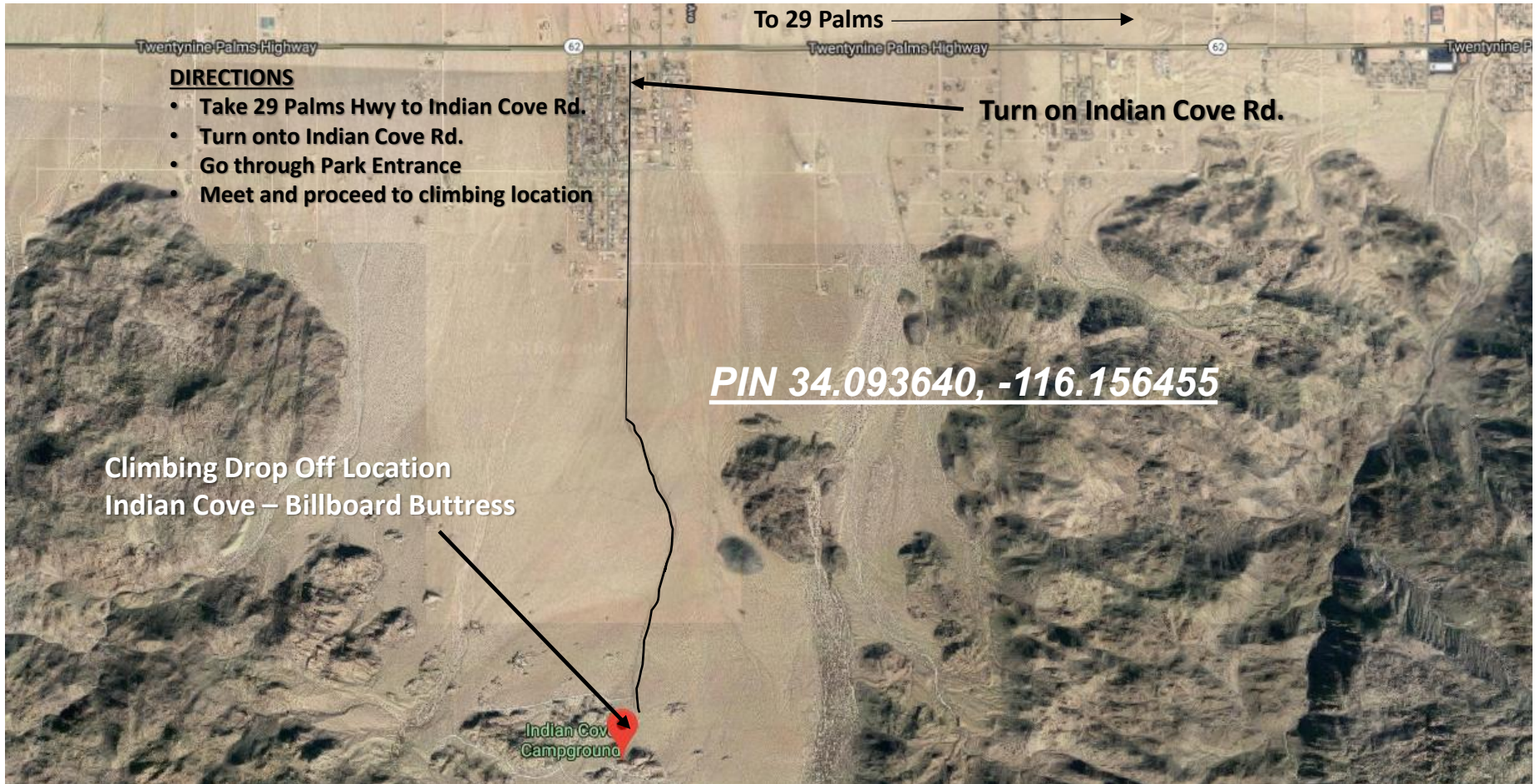
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Indian Cove - Joshua Tree National Park

Drop Off – Park at Billboard Buttress (See Map)



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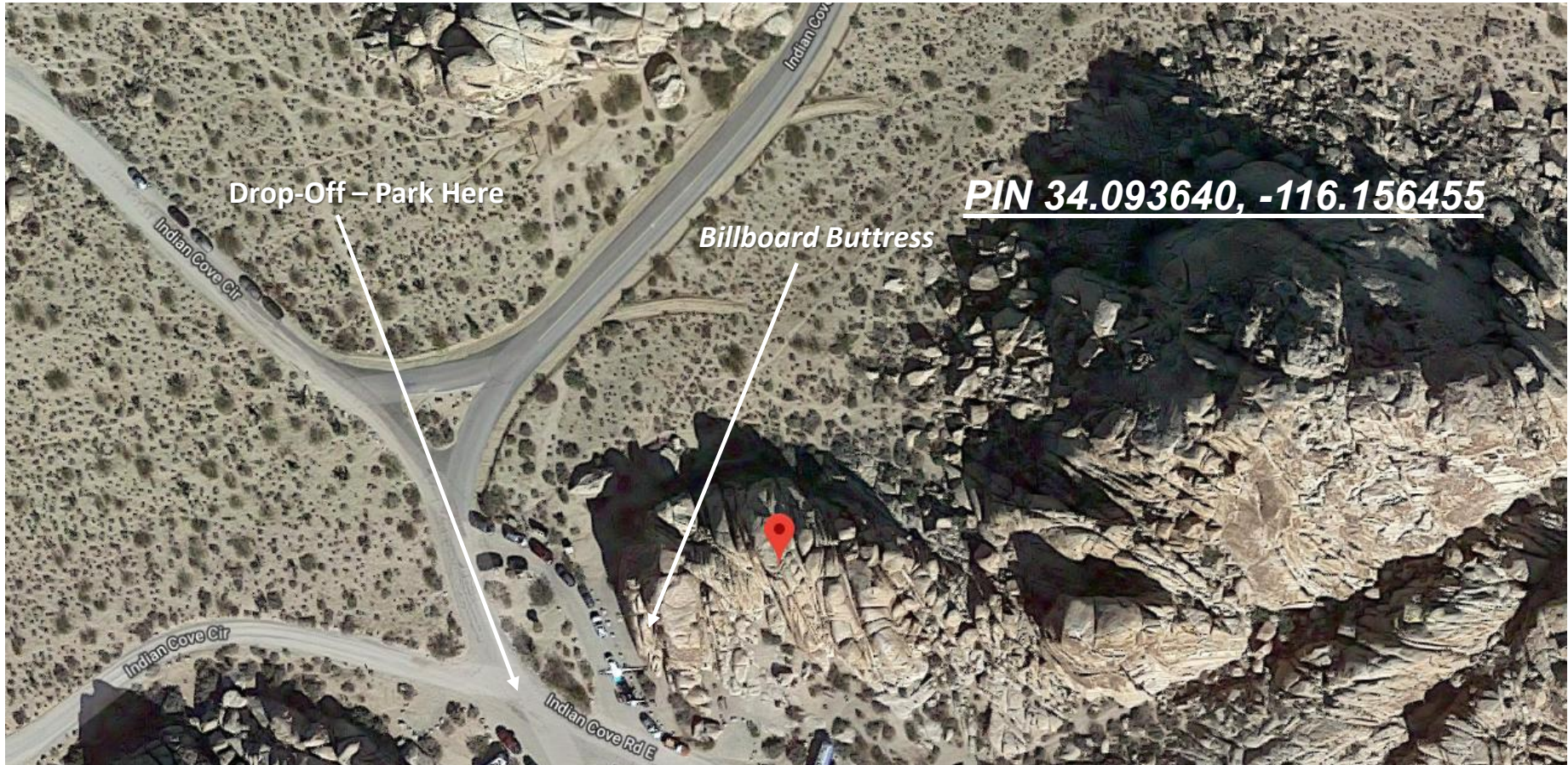
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
